Bridleways

Many routes you have ridden or still do ride may have accrued bridleway rights, by a number of people riding them for 20 years or more. If the routes are not recorded on the Definitive Map then they have little legal protection and can be closed at any time.

The Patchetts Green Bridleways Trust carry out a lot of bridleways work in the North Mymms area, especially recording historical forgotten routes and routes people currently ride, but that are not recorded, so could be lost.
