This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £30 per team or £9.50 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop www.britishhorse.com. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

Club Managers

1. 2 x helpers per team entry will be required - 1 hour per individual entry.
2. Entry forms without a correctly completed helper form (full name and contact info) shall not be processed. Teams who do not provide the required helpers shall be eliminated.

4. Please write clearly on the entry form (excel sheet) if any members have any special requirements i.e. early in the class etc.

6. No major changes will be accepted after 5pm on Monday 15th July 2019. Only straight substitutions will be accepted after this time, i.e. name of horse and/or rider taken out and replaced by another. No movements from one team to another will be allowed after this time. Times will be available on the Bozeat Riding Club web site & Facebook Page's Area 7 and Bozeat on Wednesday 17th July 2019 from 5pm
7. Declaration forms to be handed in to organiser 30 minutes before the first team class starts or the class starts for individuals.
8. No changes to teams will be accepted once declaration forms have been handed in.

- Practise fences jump must not be higher than the current class height
- Horses must not be left unattended whilst tied up to your lorry/trailer
- The Judge's decision is final.
- Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the incident and must be accompanied by £15, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
- All dogs must be kept on the lead and under control at all times
- Please remove all droppings/hay from the lorry park
- An adult must supervise children at all times
- Hair above the hair collar

- DAY BOXES £20 Available from 08:00 until 17:00 All short-term stabling includes an additional refundable £5.00 "clean box" deposit. Once you have left boxes clean Your Deposit will be returned Boxes are allocated on a "first come first served basis". Once a booking has been accepted, refunds will not be given unless the box can be re-let (£10 admin charge will be levied per box). You are welcome to bring your own bedding but NO Straw Bedding. Shavings are £12.00 per bale. Bring your own water buckets. Neither Glebe Farm Equestrian Centre, Bozeat Riding club, nor any of its representatives or staff shall be held liable for any accident, injury or damage or loss whatsoever, howsoever caused to any person animal or property at any time, and additionally accepts no duty of care for your stabled horse, dogs or property.
